912 Food Pharmacy

a produce prescription program for low-income individuals who have or are at risk of having a diet-related chronic disease. So far, we have served almost 300 participants, who have received almost \$30,000 in free produce.



Farm Truck 912

is a mobile farmers' market that brings fresh produce, purchased from local farmers at a profitable rate, into low-income, low-food-access neighborhoods. Farm Truck 912 currently has

12 stops

per week and serves more than

2500 customers

per year.
